

Conditions of Competitions

General Principle

Subject to Committee discretion, an award will only be made where at least two members in the relevant discipline / grade / category have fully qualified for the relevant competition.

Target Rifle Competitions – Off-Rifle

[1] OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP (DOUCH MEMORIAL), B GRADE CHAMPIONSHIP and C GRADE CHAMPIONSHIP - aggregate of best TWO scores at each distance during the year, possible 1,200 points, from nominated shoots.

[2] UNDER 25 CHAMPIONSHIP will be awarded to the highest placed competitor in the OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP whose 25th birthday falls after the end of the shooting year (30th June).

[3] GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP - Aggregate of OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP, plus CAMBRIDGE LONG RANGE aggregate, plus McINTOSH SERVICE SHIELD.

[4] ACTFBTR/VREEKAMP, HOWELL, THOMAS, MAHER and O'DONNELL MEDALS - Aggregate of scores in the six nominated shoots, possible 600. Medals for top scorers in each grade.

[5] RANGE MEDALS - Aggregate of best THREE scores at the nominated distance during the year, possible 300. Donors:

300 ROBINSON	B/C - 2/30 th BTTN;
400 COURTNEY	B/C - LAMB;
500 CHALLEN	B/C - TRIJICON;
600 FOX	B/C - vacancy re donor;
700 GRIBBLE	B/C - CLIFFORD;
800 NEGUS	B/C - CLIFFORD.

[6] H G McINTOSH SERVICE SHIELD - Aggregate of best THREE service scores during the year, possible 225. Trophies for top scorers in each grade.

[7] CAMBRIDGE LONG RANGE – Aggregate of the best score at 800m and 900m on the ICFRA target. A single trophy for the top TR aggregate. Open to all TR grades. Possible 200.

[8] McINTOSH MEDALS - Top scorer in the James Gordon McIntosh Grand Aggregate. Must complete all matches in the lead-up and the Queens to qualify. Medal for each TR grade.

[9] BULLEN TROPHY - Runner-up in the OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP.

Target Rifle Handicap Competitions

[1] HANDICAP CHAMPIONSHIP (GORDON HAY MEMORIAL) - As for the OFF-RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP, using handicap adjusted scores.

[2] BRACK, THOMAS, PAYNE, COX, REID, JACK LLOYD MEMORIAL, **vacancy** and EDWARDS TROPHIES - Aggregate of handicap adjusted scores at nominated shoots, possible 300.

[3] R W HUDSON MEMORIAL TROPHY - Aggregate of best TWO handicap adjusted scores at both 300 and 800 metres, as nominated during the year, possible 400.

[4] ROBERTS / CRC SPOONS - Awarded to top scorer, after handicap adjustment, for each of the nominated shoots.

[5] LLOYD SHIELD - Top scorers in the Handicap Championship among B Grade and C Grade competitors. Trophies to be awarded.

[6] GREGORY SHIELD - Aggregate of handicap adjusted scores in ACTFBTR MEDAL, possible 600. Trophy to be awarded.

F Class Competitions – Off-Rifle

F Class Open (FO) and F Class Standard (FS) **as defined by SSRs.**

[1] ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES.

[2] ACTFBTR MEDAL SERIES

[4] RANGE MEDALS – note general principle – **all vacant as for donors.**

[5] TRINDALL SPOONS - Awarded to top scorer in each of F Class Standard and F Class Open for each nominated shoot.

Special Trophies

[1] CRC “100” CLOTH BADGE - Awarded to each member recording at least one double possible under Target Rifle conditions in any one year. The number achieved to be embroidered on the badge.

[2] TARGET RIFLE 10 “V” POSSIBLE; F STD 120 DOUBLE POSSIBLE; F OPEN 200 DOUBLE POSSIBLE - Gold medal for the first such possible in any one year, bronze medal for each such possible thereafter.

[3] TARGET RIFLE SERVICE POSSIBLE - Gold medal for the first such possible in any one year, bronze medal for each such possible thereafter.
