Important Announcements

The Lead Up will have one F Standard series. The Queen's F Standard series will run with two even divisions using in the first instance percentage averages as provided by Barry Davies – if no data is available the ACTFBTR will use its discretion to place a competitor in a division and that determination will be considered final.

The Tiverton Cup for Target Rifle will be club based, but state based for both F Standard and F Open. All comer teams may also participate but only for the sweepstake prize money option. To be fired Thursday 18 November – after Lead Up.

ICFRA targets as modified by the ACTFBTR will be used by all disciplines and categories. In particular, note that at 700 m and 800 m the aiming mark will define the inner four. All bullseyes and aiming marks will be as defined by the ICFRA rules.
